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Call for nominations

Nominations are invited from current paid-up PSSA members who are recent graduates (graduated from their first pharmacy degree less than five years ago) or who are under the age of 35. Nominees have to be a member of PSSA since 24 January 2020 (minimum six months prior to elections) as per the YPG Operating Guidelines.

The positions of the steering committee are as follows:

1. Chair
2. Project coordinator (PC)
3. Public relations officer (PRO)

Nominees must have a sound understanding of PSSA, its vision, mission and structures. Previous experience in a PSSA branch or structure is compulsory. *SAPSF experience or exposure will not be considered valid as SAPSF is not part of the PSSA structure.*

Previous formal leadership and management training such as conducting a meeting, effective minute-taking, project management, effective communication, working in a team, time management, etc would be an added advantage.

Nominees should motivate why they would be an ideal candidate for the steering committee, what value and skills they will bring to the team and to PSSA and whether they have sufficient time available to effectively participate in and contribute to YPG (minimum 2 hours per week).

A comprehensive CV and professional photo should accompany the Nomination Form.
